



SALÓN DE USOS MÚLTIPLES TARBUT

The Tarbut School is located in the western zone of Mexico City. The project needed a multipurpose building where sport activities could be developed as a cultural tradition, since climatic conditions demand more of this. The building element known as a "staple" leans but is also reconciled to the building, taking in the topography from the land, thus generating circulation and services. Back-to-back volumes are featured to the east and west with great variety of colors, thus interacting with the sta as with the ravine. Features include a gym, cellar, multimedia classroom, artistic activity area, and a projection room.

PLAZA RESIDENCES

Its base is formed by stony materials, which gives continuity to the urban plan, granting presence to the first levels that lodge commercial and common services areas. The main volume of Plaza Residences by Migdal Arquitectos which incorporates the architects Jaime Varon, Abraham Metta, and Alex Metta, is developed from an outline in a horseshoe form that surrounds the Public square of Columbus, while a sequence of volumes is opened towards Paseo de la Reforma conforming its facades.
